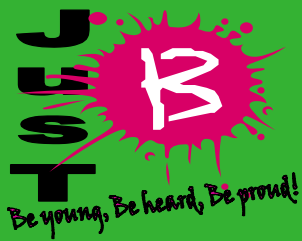
Ensure that every young person has the skills and resources to live independently
